PANORAMIC CASTLES FULL DAY - PRIVATE VISITS

The best way to really understand a place is to find out its history and there's no better way to do that than by visiting its oldest and finest buildings. Take a day to discover the charm, past and present of the Loire Valley, visiting three of the main castles in this lovely region.

VILLANDRY

The last château to have been built during the Renaissance in the Loire Valley, Villandry's understated elegance combined with the charm of its remarkable gardens make this castle one of the jewels of the World Heritage.

Mister Carvallo reinvented the fabulous gardens at the beginning of the 20th century.

CHENONCEAU

With its feminine elegance, it is a gem of the Renaissance with rich furniture and master's Paintings. Lying over the Cher, a Loire tributary, this chateau is the work of three passionate 15th century women. The Diane de Poitiers and Catherine de Medici Gardens are not to be missed either. Indulge in a fine lunch in Chenonceau (Liberty). Your local guide will choose a delightful restaurant in the area so it's sure to be a delicious experience.

CHAMBORD

Desired by Francois 1er as a hunting lodge in 1519, this grandiose castle mixes the style of a medieval fortress with the elegance of the Italian Renaissance. Leonardo da Vinci left his mark through the main stairway using a double helix revolution similar to DNA.

Note: An English-speaking driver/guide will meet you at The Condor. It takes around 4-hour drive in total.

PRIVATE VINEYARD TOURS

With The Condor located in the Loire Valley some of the best wine regions in the world are within close proximity. Below is the suggested itinerary for the Sancerre Region. Sancerre is a 90-minute drive so it would be a full day tour.

- Classical Wine Tour
- Discovery of the vineyard's landscapes, soils, grape varieties.
- Visit of two or three wineries and wine tasting of the different wines of the domain.
- Visit of a goat cheese farm with explanations about the process of making it and tasting of different matured goat cheeses.
- You have the choice of the following regions: Sancerre, Pouilly-Fumé or the combinations Pouilly-Fumé and Coteaux du Giennois or Sancerre and Menetou Salon.



CHÂTEAU DE MEUNG-SUR-LOIRE

MEUNG-SUR-LOIRE

Built in the 13th century, the Château de Meung-sur-Loire was the official residence of the bishops of Orl ans up to the French Revolution. Treat yourself to a truly surprising tour focusing on day-to-day life at the castle: over 20 furnished rooms to visit, 2,000 objects to admire and a scented trail to follow, over a genuinely immersive experience!

Your visit will take you from the superb attic to the dark underground galleries, from the magnificent neo-Classical chapel to the 18thcentury bathrooms. Follow in the footsteps of Kings Louis XI and Francis I, Joan of Arc and the poet, Fran ois Villon, who were all accommodated in the castle prison.

And make the most of the splendid 7 hectares of wooded grounds in the very centre of the town - a nostalgic insight into the site's bygone splendour... Although nothing remains of the French formal garden that once adorned the terrace, you can still admire the vestiges of the landscaped garden created just before the French Revolution.









CHÂTEAU DE LA FERT-SAINT-AUBIN

LA FERTE-SAINT-AUBIN

Here, life at the castle is a family affair, in this private 17th-century property which has been occupied for over 350 years. Over an unaccompanied tour, discover its rooms over three floors. During the summer and on Sundays, the afternoon is the opportunity to indulge in a taste of some delicious madeleine cakelets prepared by our in-house costumed cooks, who are delighted to offer you an insight into how a 17th-century kitchen was organised. From the castle, which you can tour from cellar to attic, to the stables, via the toy attic offering a display of porcelain dolls and old toys, come and discover one of the Loire Valley's quite different castles!





Outdoors, amidst the 40-hectare historic estate, you can discover some giant garden games: chess board, 15-hole mini-golf, life-size goose game across a 500-metre trail through the woods, etc. And when you return to the castle, don't miss the small farm, home to miniature animals and the village of Jolibois, with its small half-timbered houses for children. From May to September: set off on the 'Parcours des Poisons' poison adventure trail... Solve riddles, overcome obstacles, create your own poison to eliminate your rivals and find your way before it's too late!



CHÂTEAU DE LA BUSSIERE

LA BUSSIERE

Castle, grounds, vegetable garden and pond - a visit that takes you through a taste of nature's best. The castle is poised on a strikingly charming pond. Take a stroll through the shaded alleys of the 17thcentury gardens, designed by André Le Nôtre. Then amble your way through the vast 18th-century natural vegetable plot. Along your way, you will discover trained fruit trees, medicinal plants, some hundred different rose varieties, vegetable plots, etc. Here, mother nature offers you an everchanging journey through the five senses and the four seasons. With family or friends, continue your tour through the cabins in search of the thief who stole the castle keys, or take part in an escape game. And what better way to relax after your adventurous tour than a bucolic boat trip or some summer fruit picking? Collection of objets d'art on freshwater fishing. Below the castle, the 18th-century vegetable garden, awarded the 'Remarkable Garden' quality label, promises a delightful experience as you meander your way through the trained apple and pear trees, old vegetable plots,

100 varieties of tomatoes, cucurbits, aromatic and medicinal plants, and summer fruits to pick. As you leave these horticultural plots, take to the 'Cabin Trail' in the estate and, with your children, hunt for the 10 small constructions scattered across this natural site via a series of riddles in the 'Who stole the castle keys?' adventure. Fun times in store for the whole family! Inside the castle, visitors discover the great passion of one particular gentleman for freshwater fishing, via a truly original collection of objets d'art and popular traditions, displayed amidst the family furnishings. In the vegetable garden, visitors delve into a quite unique world where flowers, vegetables and fruits are grown using natural gardening techniques.







CHAMBORD NATIONAL ESTATE

CHAMBORD

Chambord is the star of all the châteaux of the Loire Valley. The French King Francis I, who hoped to create a masterpiece that was worthy of his power, would surely be flattered to discover what has become of his hunting lodge today.

Although Chambord was built like a medieval fortress, in the form of a square keep flanked by four towers, all its decorative features are greatly influenced by Italian Renaissance style, starting with the famous double spiral staircase. Classical mouldings, pilasters with capitals, interlacing and rosettes: ornamental vocabulary here is inspired by the Italian model. References to the salamander, the emblem of King Francis I, can be found over 300 times in the carved vaulting and on the walls, spitting drops of water or swallowing flames. It is symbolic of the king's presence here, even if the latter spent very little time at Chambord, the primary aim of which was to impress his royal court.

Most of its 40 lodgings were devoid of furniture; so, one can imagine the merry waltz of the domestics as they hastily adorned the castle in preparation for the arrival of its high society guests. Today, the castle provides visitors with digital tablets equipped with augmented reality and offering an insight into what Chambord looked like five centuries ago. Yet no need to augment the magnetism of this fascinating edifice... and of the entire Estate. The latter covers a surface area of 5,440 hectares, forming the largest enclosed forest in Europe, which is also a national hunting and wild fauna reserve since 1947. Over 800 stags and does, together with 1,500 wild boar, have taken up residence in this environment of oak trees, heaths, marshes and clearings.



THE PALACE OF VERSAILLES

VERSAILLES

A listed Unesco World Heritage site for the past 30 years, the Palace of Versailles is unquestionably one of the finest examples of 17thcentury French art. This former hunting lodge, built for King Louis XIII, was transformed and extended by his son, Louis XIV, who established his court and government there in 1682. Up to the French Revolution, the successive kings enhanced the palace, each one adding his own personal touch. Today, it comprises 2,300 rooms, for a total surface area of 63,154m². Yet, in 1789, the French Revolution forced Louis XVI to leave Versailles and to head for Paris. From then on, the palace was no longer used as a royal residence and, in the



19th century, it was offered a new lease of life when, in 1837, it became the Museum of the History of France, under the impetus of Louis Philippe, who took the throne in 1830. The palace rooms were adorned with new collections of paintings and sculptures, equally representative of the great figures in French history and its major events. These collections continued to be enhanced up to the early 20th century. At that point in time, under the influence of its most eminent curator, Pierre de Nolhac, the palace renewed links with its intrinsic history, the central body of the edifice donning once more the allure of a royal residence under the Ancien Régime.







CHÂTEAU DE FONTAINEBLEAU

FONTAINEBLEAU

Fontainebleau is the only castle to have been occupied by all sovereigns from the 12th to the 19th century, and it is the most richly furnished of all French royal castles. Housing over 1,500 rooms, it offers a taste of the Renaissance masterpieces commissioned by Francis I, the elegant interiors requested by Marie-Antoinette, Napoleon Bonaparte's sumptuous apartment, the influence of Napoleon III and Eugénie, etc. Equally a hunting lodge and a holiday residence, it bears fine witness to the official and intimate facets of life as a sovereign.













THE JAVELIÈRE GARDENS

MONTBARROIS

The Javelière Gardens comprise a landscaped estate that is home to a fine CCVS (Specialised Plant Collection Conservancy) certified collection of botanical, old and modern roses, for a total of some 600 different varieties. Indeed, this marvellous garden, over a variety of atmospheres, offers us all the imaginable facets of our magnificent roses - poetic and botanic, old and modern, floral or fruit bearing - pure paradise for rose lovers over the four seasons: the modern rose garden and decorative pond, old roses that grow wild round the pond and throughout the estate, the Rosarium boasting a collection of around 300 taxons of botanical roses from China, American and the Middle East, which was awarded the CCVS (Specialised Plant Collection Conservancy) 'Collection Nationale' label in 2006. Historic snippet: In the early 18th century, Pèlerin de la Buxière headed for Santo Domingo, where he acquired sugar cane plantations, hoping to strike it rich. His son Louis-Jean, who was born in Santo Domingo, purchased the seigniories of Nibelle and La Javelière upon his return to France in 1778. The Noisette rose family was brought in from Santo Domingo in the early 19th century. It was the botanist Philippe Noisette who cultivated the very first rose in this family by cross breeding a Rosa chinensis with a Rosa moschata. Hence, he obtained the adorable Blush Noisette, a rose that is still highly popular among amateurs and that was painted by Redouté and even depicted in the second volume of his work under the title, Rosier de Philippe Noisette.







ARBORETUM DES GRANDES BRUYÈRES

INGRANNES

The Arboretum des Grandes Bruvères is a genuine haven of peace in the heart of Orléans Forest. This botanical garden is a genuine invitation to relax and discover. Both a contemporary arboretum and a 'Remarkable Garden', it harmoniously associates pleasant walkways and an insight into exotic trees from other temperate climates across the globe. It is home to 7 nationally acknowledged collections, around 7,000 trees and shrubs and several species of undergrowth plants, heathers in particular. It is a genuine ballet of flowers, colours and fruits, from the promise of spring to the exuberance of autumn. Throughout

the Arboretum's 14 hectares, collections are presented via two geographical arboretums and eight themed gardens. Roses are omnipresent. The arboretum reunites some 800 rose trees, most of which are old varieties. Some of them rigorously follow the layout of the geometric garden, whilst others freely coil their floral garlands around the trees. Offered particular pride of place in the formal garden and the maze, they also illuminate the undergrowth and the entire estate. Since its creation, commitment to preserving the forest environment and its natural balance has led to the banning of any chemical agents, fertilisers or pesticides. The site is consequently home to a large population of mammals, amphibians, birds, insects, etc. the numbers of which are regularly controlled by specialised scientists. A timeless corner of paradise to escape for a few hours.











PRINTING MUSEUM AND WORKSHOP

LE MALESHERBOIS

A totally revamped industrial site, converted into a museum. A visit to the AMI offers you a fascinating delve into the story of printing. From Gutenberg to the digital revolution, a genuine army of 150 presses committed to offering the latest in knowledge and information accompany you along this fascinating initiation. THE BELVEDERE

The interactive exhibition at the Belvedere offers you an insight into the history of Fleury Abbey, in Saint-Benoit-sur-Loire. Guided tours, workshops and activities on this splendid heritage are all on the agenda at the Saint-Benoit-sur-Loire Belvedere. Located just a stone's throw from the basilica, the Belvedere is a new facility for tourism and culture, focusing on the history of Fleury Abbey, founded on the banks of the Loire in the 5th century. Through an interactive exhibition, discover the major phases of the development of this abbey, which was a major intellectual site in the Medieval Western World, and explore the secrets of the architecture of its abbey-church, a masterpiece in Roman art. All year long, the Belvedere's cultural team welcomes visitors of all ages to join a range of events focusing on heritage: guided tours, workshops, conferences, storytelling, etc.

















MUSÉE DES BEAUX ARTS (FINE ARTS MUSEUM)

ORLÉANS

For example, on the mezzanine floor, the 19th-century collections offer a representative panorama, from Neoclassicism to Romanticism and from Academicism to Realism. The splendid Pastel Cabinet is the museum collection's flagships and most likely the finest in France after that of the Louvre. It comprises major 18th-century works, such as the famous self-portrait with spectacles by Chardin or the portrait of a Young Negro by Quentin de la Tour.
