Wine Tour

Each wine tour includes an introduction about the history of the company, the visit of the cellar with the explanation on the wine making process from the harvest of the grapes to the bottling, the visit of the barrel room and the historic cellar. The tour will end up in the tasting areas with the wine and olive oil tasting and the explanation of their organoleptic characteristics.

In this experience you can taste our territory in every single step ...

Guided tour of a biodynamic estate Lenzini, dedicated to the production of wine and olive oil, with tasting of typical products and lunch, located on the gentle hills of Lucca.

The estate extends for 24 hectares, set in a natural amphitheater that frames it, where the Via Francigena also passed. Composed of 13 hectares of vineyards and 4 of olive groves, the property was born in the 16th century. Starting in 2007, the company underwent a profound change: first organic management, then the transition to biodynamic philosophy.

Take a stroll through the vineyards with an expert local winemaker and learn about the history and techniques for selecting the best grapes. Taste a few grapes or grab a pair of secateurs and a bucket and try your hand at picking grapes.

Visit the wineries, where, in the scent of must and the suffused lighting, you can discover the secrets of grape processing and wine making or enjoy a guided tour in the local vinery.

Afterwards, take part in an unconventional tasting and savour some renowned wines or sparkling wines paired with local food specialities. Alternatively, enjoy a pleasant picnic in the vineyards with zero-miles wines and food!

Hiking and Wine Experience - 5 Terre







The Cinque Terre are UNESCO world heritage and a cultural landscape of great scenic, natural and cultural value. The so-called "the Five Lands" are the five villages: Riomaggiore, Manarola, Corniglia, Vernazza and Monterosso al Mare. Five little jewels between sea, rocks and vineyards.

One of the most authentic Cinque Terre experiences is without doubt a beautiful hike off the "beaten tracks". In the morning you will be taken by a private driver from the hotel to La Spezia where you meet your English-speaking, local hiking guide. Together you continue your journey right into the heart of the Cinque Terre National Park, following the scenic mountain road all the way to Corniglia. This is the only one of the five villages that is not built directly at the water's edge, but it sits on a rocky perch with a fantastic view over the surrounding hills and the sea below. It features the characteristic tower-houses painted in bright shades of yellow, pink and peach. The terrain is characterized by the narrow, steep terraces where lemons, olives and wine are cultivated. Corniglia is the starting point of your hike.

The path leads right through the vineyards and you can watch the boats going past down below and the birds dancing in the breeze. The steep slopes of this area are covered with a high vegetation consisting of several shrubs, such as rockroses, heaths, spurges and strawberry trees. There are also some aromatic plants such as the rosemary, thyme, curry plant and lavender. The caper, growing in the clefts of the dry-stone walls, is a remaining cultivation from the last century.

Once you have arrived at the hamlet Volastra you will meet a local winegrower and be offered a wine tasting with snacks in his little cellar. After this unique experience a long romantic stairway through olive groves leads down to the picturesque town of Manarola where you have some time for leisure. In the afternoon you will take the ferry boat to Portovenere. This is a final highlight and you will enjoy the relaxing trip on the boat, adore the coastline now from another perspective and then take a look at the the charming town of Portovenere. From there, your driver will bring you back to the hotel.



Hiking in the middle of Apuan Alps





The professional mountain guides have in store many appointments for trekking enthusiasts, to discover exceptional and breathtaking places.

Apuane park is located in Tuscany, only for his geo-morphological and naturalistic characteristics, it is developed for around 60 kms along the coast of the Tyrrhenian sea in the areas of the Versilia, Lunigiana and Garfagnana.

You will walk along ancient paths, through woods to reach the summit of a mountain, surrounded by breathtaking views overlooking charming valleys and the sea coast far away.

The Monte Procinto- hiking in fixed rope route

The Via Ferrata is a complex of structures and technical gear fixed on a rocky mountain side to make easier and safer for the climber to reach the top. This particular via ferrata is also suitable for children from 8 years old and up, and you will be always accompanied by a professional, authorized, English speaking alpine guide to ensure your safety.

The Monte Forato trekking

Monte Forato is one of the most common destinations in the Apuan Alps because of the suggestive natural arch that joins two twin peaks and creates a hole that can be seen from Garfagnana and Versilia.

The hike is moderate-demanding in difficulty since it includes a dislevel of about 800 meters

The Legend of Monte Forato

One of the many legends heard in Garfagnana regards the origin of the hole in the mountain. Legend has it that it was caused during a tremendous clash between Saint Pellegrino and the Devil himself.

The Devil, tired of seeing the saint prey and sing all day, sought to tempt him while he was making a beech wood cross, but it was all in vain. Irritated, the Devil slapped the saint so hard he was knocked down. San Pellegrino slowly got back up and also tired of the continuous torments he was made to endure, instead of turning the other cheek slapped the Devil right back so hard he was hurled against the crest of the mountain. The Devil hit the mountain with his head, the terrible impact created the hole that we can see today.

Climbing on the Sea - The Gulf of Poets



A thrilling way to get close to our spectacular coastal landscape!

This tour is for both: people with rock climbing experience as well as for those who want to try it for their first time.

It is lead by professional English speaking Mountain Guide. One of the most scenic spot in the mediterranean area between Portovenere and Cinque Terre The Spot is at about 300 mt above sea level and it can be reached by 45 min. of panoramic har or by car.

Easy, half day € 350,00 (max 4): we reach the spot by car, climbing half day and then you can reach Portovenere on your self by easy trail,

Difficult, full day € 425 (max 2): we climb all day and if the sea condition allow it we can go at the beginning of climbing by private boat (€ 10,00 per person)



Walking among the most beautiful villas and gardens of Lucca



A fascinating journey through some of the most beautiful historic palaces

Hotel Byron has created an exclusive itinerary that will take you to the discovery of elegant and fascinating villas and gardens of great history, drawing a wonderful path in the area of Lucca. Surrounded by hills, these veritable country palaces were built by wealthy Lucchesi merchants from the fifteenth century onwards and represent an important heritage of Italian history.

Our journey starts from Villa Reale di Marlia, which was the residence of Elisa Baciocchi, sister of Napoleon and sovereign of Lucca. She purchased the villa in 1806, and it was then re-baptized with the name Villa Reale (Royal Palace) after her regal status. She proceeded to make many changes to the gardens, extending the property, adding nearby residences to the main body of the estate and to the villa itself.

In San Pancrazio, near Lucca, you can visit Villa Oliva Buonvisi, dating back to the sixteenth century, with a splendid park that extends over five hectares, and is characterized by various water features and waterfalls, bas-reliefs and statues.

Also in San Pancrazio we find Villa Grabau, built in the 16th century by the Diodati family of Lucchese merchants, on the ruins of a medieval village. The owners modified the villa to transform its original Gothic features into the current neoclassical features. The surrounding park has a beautiful English-style garden and an Italian-style oval garden, with fountains and a hundred terracotta lemon-houses with the coats of arms of the noble families.

In Camigliano, you can admire Villa Torrigiani, a luxurious sixteenth-century building in Tuscan Baroque style, with flower-filled gardens full of camellias and pools of water. The villa is like a small palace, inspired by Versailles, with the note the Flora Garden-Theater, whose caves and spectacular water features are still functioning.

Visit of Tuscan cigar manufactories in Lucca





Guided tour of the Tuscan cigar manufactories in Lucca

Discover the world of Tuscan cigar manufactories through the guided tour of the Lucca factory.

For almost 130 years, beginning in 1818, cigar manufacturing took place mainly in Florence. But in the years following the postwar period the 'stortignaccolo' or 'crooked cigar' left the Tuscan capital for good and transferred its production to factories in Lucca and Cava de' Tirreni. Starting from around 1853 until June 2004 the main Lucca factory was based in a former convent for Dominican nuns. Since then, production has been moved to a more modern and functional building in Mugnano, on the outskirts of Lucca.

The tour begins among ancient machinery, intense aromas ranging from leather to smoking woods. Long and particular is the processing of the tobacco leaves that immediately pass from large boxes to the "bathroom". There are many steps required, through the various machinery, to allow the leaves to reach our beloved Tuscan. You can see some vintage-style desks, before seeing the beating heart of the manufacture: the cigar makers. At the end of the tour there will be a guided tasting of cigars and pairings with spirits, to finish the visit with taste.
